## REGISTRATION STEPS

1. Attend registration presentation.
2. Discuss options with parents, teachers, and counselors.
3. Select classes carefully – **do not expect schedule changes after registration is completed.**
4. Get signatures from parent, English teacher, and Math teacher.
5. Complete registration by SRB- see schedule in Office window – Jan 26, 30, and Feb. 1, 2006. All registrations must be completed by **Feb. 3, 2006.** Schedule requests will be completed by a counselor if deadline is not met.

Please remember – you must repeat any required classes you fail. Students at MHS do not fail grades, i.e., 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, but they may delay receiving certain privileges such as open lunch, open hour, prom attendance, graduation, etc because of a lack of credits.

Students **are not** allowed to decrease the number of courses they take after the registration process has been completed. Juniors and seniors wanting an open hour must per-register for it. Serious academic concerns could warrant adding the student to a study hall.

- You can't take English III until you have passed English I
- You must take at least one semester of PE in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade and have the PE requirement completed by the end of sophomore year,

If you have failed a required class, you must register for it again. If you fail a class second semester, please notify the counselors in writing- a form is in the office-so adjustments can be made. Failure to do so may delay your graduation.
